

CSA Tri-Meet Administration 6/1/2009

The following information is supplemental to the CSA Rules, the CSA Meet Entries and CSA Scoring procedures and is meant to provide info only where the administration of a tri-meet diverges from that of a dual meet.

Team Entries & Seeding Six Lane Pool:

The entry and C.O.C. procedures are the same as a dual meet with the following exceptions:

- Six Lane Pool Seeding:
 - Host Team (A): Lanes 3 and 5
 - Visiting Team (B): Lanes 4 and 1
 - Visiting Team (C): Lanes 2 and 6
 - Follow the above pattern for as long as each team has two swimmers per heat and then fill in empty lanes with remaining swimmers until all swimmers are seeded.

Team Entries & Seeding Eight Lane Pool:

The entry and C.O.C. procedures are the same as a dual meet with the following exceptions:

- Eight Lane Pool Seeding: For Medley Relay (events 3-12), Long Freestyle (events 29-36 and 57-58) and Individual Medley (events 67-74)

- Eight Lane Pool Seeding for all other events:

- For additional heats, begin with Team C and circle seed in a C-B-A, C-B-A pattern.

Ribbons and Three Event Winners

These are awarded in the same fashion as a dual meet.

Scoring

Points are awarded up to six (6) places with each team awarded points for their top two (2) swimmers. Points awarded by place are 7 – 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 1 for individual events. In relay events points will be awarded to the top three relay teams (10-5-3). Clubs may enter multiple relay teams, but only one (1) relay team from each club may score points.

Officials and Timers

The host team will provide the Starter and Referee. The two visiting teams will each provide two (2) Stroke & Turn judges

All teams in the meet will all provide one (1) timer per lane for a total of three timers per lane. The host team will provide the Head Timer. If the Y Bears provide automatic timing, then they are relieved from providing lane timers. The other two teams will provide one (1) timer for each lane (total of 2 per lane) for back-up.

Each team will provide the normally required number of volunteers in COC, Scoring, Card Sorting, Ribbons, etc.
